Report on Program of April Meeting

At the meeting of DRGHS on April 11, Dianne Johnston presented her recommendations concerning the reconfiguration of the kitchen at Sudduth House. She had a detailed explanation of the placement of sinks, storage, shelving and appliances that will provide caterers the essentials for serving food at social and business gatherings at the house. They included the removal of a large cabinet in the kitchen and replacing it with stainless steel shelving. She recommended that a small stove be included in our plans as well as stainless steel carts for more workspace as well as for moving prepared dishes to the serving areas.

Dianne also provided examples of contracts that are appropriate for the public use of the Sudduth House. We want to make this home a place where the community can enjoy good experiences with safety and convenience.

Dianne and her partners have had years of experience in the catering business. We feel so fortunate and appreciate that she has taken the time to advise us and has made her expertise available to us as we move forward toward our goal of creating a community home.
